



Changes brought to the trucking route to reduce traffic on Henri-Bourassa Boulevard

To all truck drivers transiting through the Beauport sector

The urbanization of this boulevard and the presence of trucks due to industrial and municipal activities have caused an increase in traffic in this area. This has led to growing concerns among the surrounding population.

The Quebec Port Authority (QPA) understands the important impact that maritime and port activities taking place on its territory has had on the neighbouring community and wishes to address the situation.

Beauport sector

As of now, the QPA asks both partners and users of the Beauport sector to voluntarily take part in a **collective initiative** to reduce traffic entering and exiting the Beauport port sector by taking the **Felix-Leclerc highway (A-40)** or the **Dufferin-Montmorency highway (A-440)**, rather than Henri-Bourassa Boulevard, which passes through Cité-Limoilou.

As a result, and insofar as possible, only local traffic should be allowed on Henri-Bourassa Boulevard.
