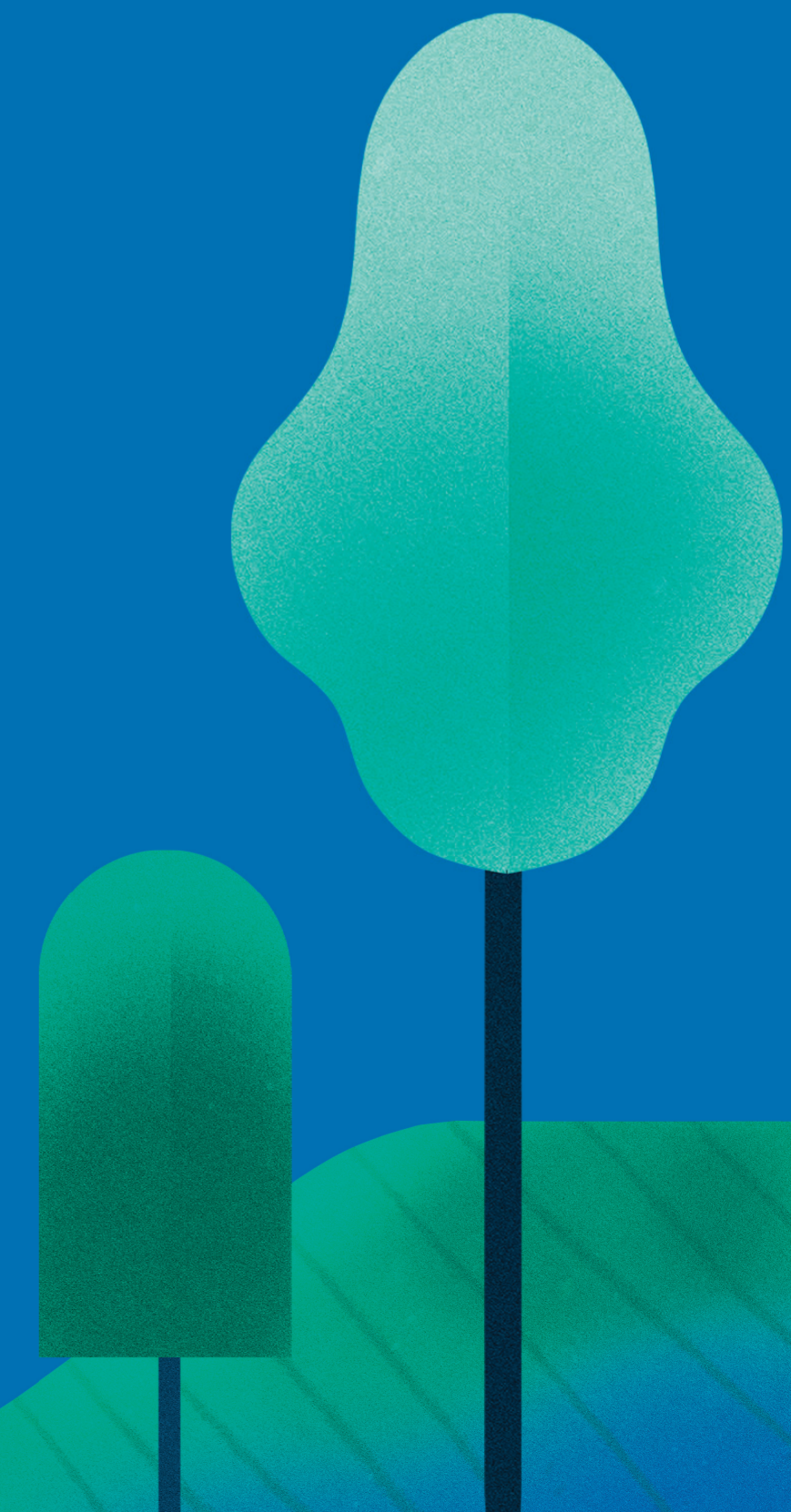
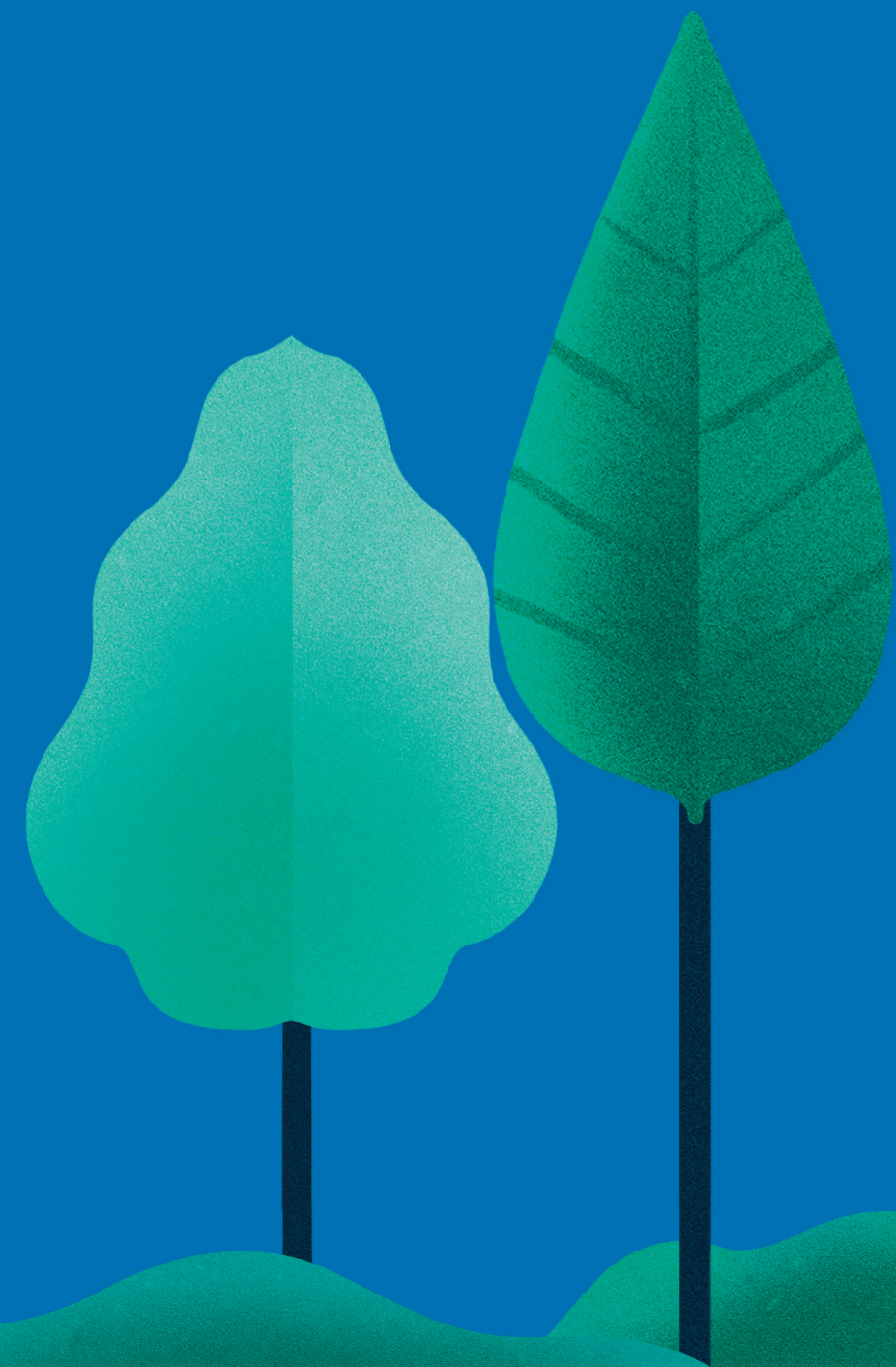


Taking concrete action for biodiversity
